

IQ (Cognitive Ability) Assessment Schedule

- Students can be given an IQ assessment twice throughout their time in Rockwood (the WISC-V is the only IQ assessment that Rockwood administers for grades 1-12).
- There is a minimum of two years between each WISC-V administration.
- This table outlines the earliest date that a student can be reassessed for IQ after being given a WISC-V (WPPSI-IV for Kindergarten assessment*).

- Students that have taken the WISC-V twice, will not be eligible to be reevaluated for the Rockwood Gifted Program.
- *Kindergarten assessment is not included in the two IQ assessment limit, however, students are not eligible for reassessment until the start of their 2nd grade year.
